Reading Task:

Today, your reading task is to practise and perform your story map from yesterday. Take time to learn to read it with flow and most of all, expression!! Maybe you could perform it to whoever you live with? I would absolutely love it if you could film yourself and upload it to your scrapbook or email it to me. You might even find you can eventually tell the story perfectly with no story map at all!

Writing task:

Choose a different well known fairy tale and, just like the writer did in yesterday's reading, alter the characters in some way. This is a short version of a fairy tales so you do not need to write pages and pages. Stick to a similar length and format to yesterday's example. Remember you can magpie the great vocabulary used in there.

When you are considering how to alter your characters, you could make females male and males females like in yesterday's example, however, you could also alter the personalities of the characters instead. For example, you could choose Cinderella again, however, she could be brave and strong and could stand up for herself right from the beginning with her evil stepmother...how would that story end I wonder? Get creative! Make it exciting!
