Dear Parents and Guardians,

As you may be aware, all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for Universal Free School Meals. All pupils in these year groups will be able to receive a school meal at no cost to the parent/guardian.

However, some children may be eligible to receive Pupil Premium Free School Meals as an alternative. We are asking parents and guardians whose income would entitle them to the Pupil Premium (see below criteria) and would therefore have a statutory entitlement to a Pupil Premium Free School Meal to complete this form. **PLEASE DO NOT RETURN THIS FORM UNTIL MID-JULY AND ENSURE THE FORM IS FULLY COMPLETED**

We will then be able to confirm whether the school is entitled to claim the pupil premium for your child.

The Pupil Premium is extra money given to your child's school to spend on resources such as one to one tutoring, help with school trips etc. For 2020/20201 we believe this will be **£1320 per pupil**. Funding is based on children registered for a free school meal, further reinforcing the importance of making sure all those who qualify are actually registered.

Please complete all sections on the form if your income meets one of the categories below and either return it to your school or local benefit office, this will be processed in confidence by the Local Authority.

Your child may be entitled to receive free school meals if you are entitled to receive one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190
- Universal Credit (Provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than **£7,400**)
