Reading task:

It might seem odd that your reading task does not involve much reading today. However, we can 'read' pictures. Each door above tells us so much, without needing to use words at all! Have a go at the following reading questions.

1. Can you think of exciting adjectives to describe each of the doors?
2. If you put your ear to each door, what noises could you hear coming from the other side? Explain your reasons for each.
3. What noise would each door make if you opened it?
4. Give a very brief description of who could live / what could exist behind each door and why you think that.

Writing task:

Today you are really going to have to use your imagination and get those creative juices flowing. Choose one of the doors and using your practice from yesterday, write a character description of the person who lives behind it. You may use DADWAVERS if you like, or you can just vary the sentence openers yourself. Remember to SHOW me, not tell me who lives behind the door. And also remember that this is a CHARACTER DESCRIPTION...there shouldn't be any action.
